DEQ sets public meeting Tuesday

A public meeting will be held for the presentation by the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality's (DEQ) proposed plan for the remediation of the ecological areas of concern around the old Blackwell zinc smelter site.

The meeting with the DEQ will be 6:30 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 30, in the Commission Chambers at the Blackwell City Hall.

The DEQ has set the public session to receive comments from the public regarding its plan.

The proposed plan will focus on the alternative being considered to address elevated metals concentrations in surface waters and stream sediments.

The primary areas of concern are the stream which flows through Legion Park and the stream along Ferguson Avenue.

The public is being encouraged by the DEQ to comment on the proposed plan. Comments may be submitted in writing or given orally at the public meeting.
