

**KAY CO. GRAND JURY
SUBMISSION OF QUESTION**

I, Claude Williams Bill Williams,
formally request the Kay Co. Grand Jury to consider the following question
for review.

**Did the City of Blackwell violate the Oklahoma Open Meetings Act
by posting notice of city meeting inside City buildings, so that such
notice could not be read or viewed after business hours?**

For the past decade, Bill and Claude Williams have been active in the local
government. They attended countless City Council, BMA, and BIA meetings.
They also claim that during their ten years of participation, the City has failed to
post their meetings correctly.

The City of Blackwell had a habit of posting their meeting notice and
agenda inside the City Hall building on a bulletin board. These posted notices
and agendas could not have been seen from the outside of City Hall after hours.
If a citizen wanted to know what was on the agenda they would have had to go
into the City Hall offices during business hours. This process was intentionally
designed to thwart transparency.
